#### FROM THE BOARD

2024 was another year in which there was a lot to report. Our board met on October 5 for the annual meeting. The other matters were discussed throughout the year by email, telephone or in person.

There was a project visit to Nepal in February 2024 and one to Bolivia in April 2024.

Bangladesh: We have decided to support SUKP financially for a longer period of time and at the same time, together with them, to look for possibilities to make them independent.

Nepal: We are cautious about financing 5 students in Nepal, as long as Rashmi does not comply with the request for reporting.

Bolivia: Only at the end of 2024 was the donated amount of December 2023 used for the children of La Aldea, with whom we are still in contact. In the meantime, there is also a proper accountability. We are cautious about new requests.

### SPOT

We have contact with SPOT a few times a year. The participants of this shop/studio of people with a need for help grow in the realization that there are more people in the world like them. They are very concerned about the children of SUKP in Bangladesh. For example, they were concerned when there were student protests that eventually led to the deposition of the long-serving prime minister of Bangladesh, but also when the persistent rains caused many floods. Bangladesh is a large delta area and floods occur there every year, but, just like in the rest of the world, it is also becoming more extreme here. That is much more difficult to tackle for a country with a large poor population than here in our rich west.

This year, P3M again received the tip jar with the nice amount of € 301.63, - intended for extra physiotherapy lessons for parents and teachers of SUKP. The children benefit from this!

### DOUGHNUT DRIVE

For the 2nd year in a row, our neighbor Ton organized a doughnut drive in our street. He almost went under because of the success! Result € 276.50 is also intended for extra physiotherapy lessons for the parents and teachers of SUKP. We received the amount early January 2025.

### BOOK SELLING

Also there was the proceeds from the book sale by another neighbor, who's name is Ton as well. €350,- for the general support of SUKP.

### IN BANGLADESH

#### SUN CHILDREN € 1.600,-

This year Lamia received her HSC certificate. She is the 2nd Sun-Child sponsored by us that has come this far! Diba got married this year at the age of 19, after receiving her SSC certificate also a nice milestone. The 5 girls, who are still allowed to finish their secondary school, are all doing well!

### **SUKP € 7.104, -**

For SUKP we transfer a quarterly contribution of € 1500, - and € 1.004,- for uniforms as a Christmas present and extra physiotherapy lessons.

The discussion we have with each other about sustainability and finding their own funds results in the start of a pilot from the end of 2024. The rent of a piece of land for the planting of bananas and pineapple as cash crop and costs a one-off € 2000, -. The expected yield is BTK 20,000 ± € 200 per year for SUKP and the same amount for the parents, who will take on the work.

When the rent ends, the deposit is refunded and can be used again for other purposes. We know that more of these initiatives are needed, but it is a start.

### **IN NEPAL**

#### **STEPPING STONE €550,-**

Reporting is a bit slow, so we only sent half of the required amount last year. We finally received some reports in January 2025.

- Rinky has completed her high school exams and passed! She can now also take the entrance exam for the university.
- Rahul is in the last year of the secondary technical school and is doing well. He is the only one who also contacts us occasionally. Exam in April and results 3 months later.
- Ram Binay is in class 9 [of 12] of the secondary technical school.
- Preeti did not do her school transfer exams. She has problems in the family atmosphere. She is not going to school for the time being.



Daroga has passed the entrance exam of the University. He has applied for a scholarship. He is waiting for a go-ahead and we are waiting for the amount he needs for other things.

**SATHYA UDDHYAN € 2010,-**

We visited the school in Februari 2024. This is running well and we were warmly welcomed again.



We brought our 2 oldest grandchildren Ambia and Djamun to introduce them to our work. Of course we had to give teeth brushing lessons, after the sweet snacks that we treated them. The new jackets, that they had received as a Christmas present, were just finished.

A large sink-hole has formed on the terrace of the school after the last heavy rain period in September. Rashmi applied for repairs and received money for it plus an extra retaining wall.

The costs of € 4000, - were transferred at the beginning of January 2025. The repairs will be carried out when everything has dried properly.



## IN BOLIVIA

### LA ALDEA € 2305,-

We have been working for quite some time to get the donation from Christmas 2023, intended for the children of La Aldea, back to the right place. They neglected to inform us that La Aldea was closed and that the children had been relocated to various government orphanages. However, Father Miguel Angel still has regular contact with the various children and they still need support with clothing, shoes and books. So, in April we agreed to spend the money on that, but imagine our surprise when we heard that it had been used for another purpose, namely the renovation of a nursery school in La Paz. Our protest, that without consultation, donations cannot be spent otherwise, was taken seriously and the amount was spent on the children of La Aldea at the end of 2024. We left an extra amount for the treatment of 2 girls with serious burns.

On the trip to Bolivia, we were accompanied by our grandson Jonas.



**AND MORE €650,-**

After all the years that we have worked in developing countries, we still keep in touch with a number of colleagues from back then. Every now and then we find it necessary to help one of them financially. For example, we made it possible for Josephine in Sri Lanka to purchase a sewing machine, with which she can now provide for herself somewhat better. Also we paid for a necessary operation of one of the children.
