Pilot: Cultivation of bananas, ananas and rice

The contract is signed and SUKP has acquared plot of 350 m² for an indefinite time of lease. Not too large, but therefore it will be managable.

Multiplying bananas and ananas is simple. Adult plants make new shoots at the base of the plant. You can easily cut these off and replant them. Activities that can also be done well by the children. For the pilot of SUKP, a number of parents have provided good cuttings.

Jackfruit is one of the larger tropical fruits. They do not grow on branches but on the trunk. In the Netherlands, jackfruit (semi-ripe) is sometimes used as a meat substitute. And for everyone who is feeling warm, in Bangladesh, it is hotter than 35 °C every day in May, June, and July.
